





Affordable Care Act (ACA) Net Growth PGC Health Connect




- 150,000 County residents enrolled in Medical Assistance Insurance

2016 Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA)

- In response to 2015 Primary Healthcare Strategic Plan Recommendation, the Health Department and 5 area hospitals conducted a *joint community health needs* assessment for the first time in county history.
- Our 5 hospitals, 40 community experts and the Health Department collectively agreed to focus efforts on the following priorities:
 - Behavioral Health
 - Obesity and Metabolic Syndrome
 - Cancer
 - Overall social determinants, including access to care
