



Hispanic Festival 2019 **REMINDERS**

- Fire Marshal inspection requires fire retardant tents code NFPA 701.
- Have a hard copy of the fire code certificate if possible.
- Tents should not cover the grills; grills must be on the side or on the back of the tent.
- Must have up-to-date fire extinguisher; label date must not be expired.
- Propane gas must be a minimum of 15 ft. away from public.
- Setup time is between 7 am and 10 am. If you arrive after 10 am, you will not be allowed in the food area.
- No parked cars at the cooking site; Cars at the cooking site are ONLY for loading/unloading.
- Please keep in mind that the food being stored/unused must not touch the ground at any time.
- No glass bottles allowed for sale.
- Must have a backup generator onsite.
- Remove all tripping hazards (cables, supplies, materials, etc.) from public and cooking areas.
- Fire and Health Department Inspections will start by 9 am.
- Review Health Department check list for health procedures and health inspection guide.
- DO NOT allow public behind your space. This area is unsafe for public and is a fire hazard area.
- Stop all sales by 5:45 pm and follow breakdown directions.
- Prince George's is a FOAM FREE County. DO NOT sell food in any type of Styrofoam products.
- Clean up the space no later than 7 pm.
